NEW MUSICAL TRIBUTE TO U.S. ARMED FORCES FEATURES BUSH SPEECH

Special Release By "The Americans" To Benefit National World War II Memorial in Washington, D.C.

Harrisburg, PA — Just one week after the president's State of the Union address, "*The Americans*" have released a special musical tribute containing highlights from George W. Bush's message to the U.S. Armed Forces.

"*We Will Prevail — America Standing Tall*" is the new original release from *The Americans*, and the new song contains highlights from The President's January 28 national address before the Joint Session of Congress — including the following excerpt:
